#### <u>:-NB</u>

\*Under the IBC Act, the annual fee is payable not later than the last day of the calendar quarter in which the IBC was incorporated or continued.

## **PENALTIES**

An IBC that fails to pay the annual fee by the due date shall, in addition to the annual fee, pay a penalty of an amount equal to 10% of the annual fee (e.g a company due to file its annual fee by 30th June 2007 and fails to do so, shall immediately thereafter incur a penalty of 10%, i.e US\$200 + 20 = US\$220 payable to the Government of Anguilla.)

## **FURTHERMORE**,

An IBC that fails to pay the annual fee and the (10%) penalty before the expiration of 3 months from the due date shall, in addition to the annual fee, be liable to pay a penalty of an amount equal to 50% of the annual fee (e.g using the same example above. Should this company fail to file its annual fee by the end of September, shall immediately thereafter, incur a 50% penalty, i.e US\$200 + 100 = US\$300 payable to the Government of Anguilla)

After the expiration of a further 3 months, an IBC failing to file its annual fee shall be struck off the register by the Registrar of Companies.

If the company is restored within 6 months immediately following the striking off the register the Government restoration fee is US\$300 + penalties (i.e US\$300 + US\$300 = US\$600.00)

If restored later than 6 months immediately following the striking off the register the Government restoration fee is US\$600 + penalties (i.e US\$600 + US\$300 = US\$900.00).
