2. In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 317 of the Belize Companies Act (No. 11 of 2022), and all other powers thereunto me enabling, **I, JOHN BRICEÑO,** Prime Minister and Minister responsible for finance, hereby appoint the 28th day of July, 2022, as the day on which the following provisions of the Belize Companies Act, 2022, shall come into force–

Commencement of Act No. 11 of 2022.

- (a) the provisions of Part I;
- (b) the provisions of Part XVII, other than sections 294 305 and section 307; and
- (d) sections 313, 315 and 316, other than the repeal or amendment, as the case may be, of the following enactments, as specified in Schedule III–
